यह भी अवगत कराया गया है कि ANH का Aadhaar App आधारित ऑफलाइन सत्यापन करने हेतु इच्छुक External Entities द्वारा यू0आई0डी0ए0आई0 के साथ Offline Verification Seeking Identity (OVSE) के रूप में Aadhaar (Authentication and Offline Verification) Amendment Regulations, 2025 के अनुसार पंजीकरण किया जाना होगा। इस Aadhaar App आधारित ऑफलाइन सत्यापन व्यवस्था का उपयोग विभिन्न योजनाओं/सेवाओं में पात्र व्यक्तियों, चिकित्सालयों में रोगियों, परीक्षाओं हेतु अभ्यर्थियों इत्यादि की पहचान स्थापित करने हेतु किया जा सकता है।

Dear Chief Secretary,

UIDAI had recently launched its new mobile application, Aadhaar App, that allows Aadhaar Number Holder (ANH) to securely store, show, and share **Aadhaar verifiable credentials** with any external entity for the purpose of identity verification.

2. Aadhaar app based Offline Verification enables secure identity verification, addressing challenges relating to data privacy (Aadhaar photocopy misuse), authenticity of offline Aadhaar data and proof of presence. The Aadhaar App facilitates consent-based sharing of digitally signed and tamper-proof offline Aadhaar data with provision of offline face verification, thereby providing verifiers a secure, efficient and compliant offline verification mechanism with reduced operational overhead.
3. The recent circular No HQ-30011/3/2025-AU-HO by UIDAI, dated 30.04.26, recognizes Aadhaar Verifiable Credentials shown, shared and/or verified through Aadhaar Application, as a valid mechanism for establishing identity of the Aadhaar Number Holder (Copy enclosed for ready reference).
4. Any entity desirous of undertaking Aadhaar app based Offline Verification of Aadhaar Number Holder, should register itself as an Offline Verification Seeking Entity (OVSE) with UIDAI, in accordance with the Aadhaar (Authentication and Offline Verification) Amendment Regulations, 2025 notified by Gazette notification issued on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025. Several entities including central government departments, state government departments and private entities have got registered as OVSE.
5. Aadhaar app based Offline Verification can be explored across various citizen-facing use cases such as hotel and guest house registration, visitor management at government and non-government establishments, patient verification at hospitals, candidates' verification for examination, and other service delivery ecosystems requiring reliable identity verification on day-to-day basis.
6. The entire process is designed in alignment with applicable Aadhaar regulations and the provisions of the Digital Personal Data Protection Act.
7. During recent discussions with State authorities and law-enforcement agencies, it was observed that Aadhaar app based Offline Verification mechanism can significantly ensure public safety and reduce cases of identity impersonation.
8. A brief introduction of Aadhaar App and Offline Verification is attached for ready reference.
9. In this regard, it is requested that States/UTs may explore adoption of Aadhaar App based Offline Verification at various citizen-facing services to promote ease of living for Aadhaar Number Holders and ease of doing business for verifying agencies.

**CIRCULAR**

Subject: Validity of Aadhaar Verifiable Credential shown, shared and/or verified through Aadhaar Application.

Reference:

1. Validity of downloaded Aadhaar (e-Aadhaar) as a proof of identity issued vide circular dated 28.04.2017.
2. Introduction of Aadhaar Card for use at par with other forms of Aadhaar like Aadhaar letter, e-Aadhaar, masked e-Aadhaar and m-Aadhaar dated 29.09.2020.

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) is a statutory body established under section 11 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act 2016 which came into force on 12.9.2016. UIDAI is mandated to issue a 12-digit unique identity number called an Aadhaar Number to the residents based on demographic and biometric information submitted by the resident to UIDAI during enrolment.

2. As per Section 4(3) of Aadhaar Act, 2016:

*"Every Aadhaar number holder to establish his identity, may voluntarily use his Aadhaar number in physical or electronic form by way of authentication or offline verification or in such other form as may be notified, in such manner as may be specified by the regulations".*

3. As a step towards enhancing digital enablement, UIDAI has launched a new Aadhaar Application, namely, "Aadhaar App". The Aadhaar App is available on both Android and iOS platforms. It enables the Aadhaar number holders to show, share and verify their identity in a digital manner. However, while sharing the identity details to an Offline Verification Seeking Entity (OVSE) through Aadhaar App, the 12-digit Aadhaar number is not transferred. The Aadhaar App provides the option to share either complete or partial identity details in the form of Aadhaar Verifiable Credentials of the Aadhaar number holder. The detail so shared is legally valid in terms of the provisions of Information Technology Act, 2000, which provides legal recognition to electronic records.

4. In light of the provisions of Aadhaar Act, 2016 and regulation mentioned above, Aadhaar verifiable credentials shown, shared and/or verified through the "Aadhaar App" are legally valid form to establish identity of Aadhaar number holder, in addition to other forms like Aadhaar letter, e-Aadhaar, masked e-Aadhaar, Aadhaar Card and m-Aadhaar as notified earlier.

5. All the Ministries/Departments/State Governments/Autonomous Bodies/Authorities/other agencies accepting Aadhaar as proof of identity are requested to accept Aadhaar shown and/or shared through the "Aadhaar App" as a valid establishment of identity of the Aadhaar number holder and issue necessary instructions to all concerned.

## Aadhaar app-based Offline Verification and OVSE Ecosystem

On 28<sup>th</sup> Jan, 2026, the new Aadhaar App was dedicated to the nation, marking a significant milestone in identity verification. Aadhaar app based Offline Verification enables secure identity verification, addressing challenges relating to data privacy, authenticity of offline Aadhaar data and proof of presence. The Aadhaar App facilitates consent-based sharing of digitally signed and tamper-proof offline Aadhaar data with provision of offline face verification, thereby providing Offline Verification Seeking Entity (OVSE) a secure, efficient and compliant offline verification mechanism with reduced operational overhead.

The Aadhaar App fundamentally does 2 things:

- a) **Show | Share | Verify:** It empowers ANHs to share their Aadhaar Verifiable Credentials for day-to-day Identity verification purpose, with the verifiers (like Hotels, Residential society, Fintech companies, Age-gating for entry in Cinema halls / Public Events, and many more) through a secured, privacy preserving and consent-based mechanism.
- b) **Aadhaar Services Management:** Without visiting Aadhaar Seva Kendra (ASK) or Aadhaar Enrolment & Update Centre, ANH can now utilize key Aadhaar services (like - mobile and address update, multi-profile addition, one-click biometric lock/unlock, offline face verification to establish proof of presence, offline Aadhaar QR Verification, and many more) directly from their smartphone.
  - Aadhaar app is aligned with the provisions and guiding principles of Digital Personal Data Protection (DPDP) Act, 2023.
  - Build on globally recognized interoperability standards such as OpenID for Verifiable Presentations (OpenID4VP) and World Wide Web Consortium (W3C) Verifiable Credentials.

**Registration of OVSE:** Entities can now perform Aadhaar Offline Verification without the need to connect to UIDAI's database, i.e. Central Identities Data Repository (CIDR). This offline verification mechanism provides a trusted, consent-based, and privacy-preserving alternative to traditional Aadhaar authentication. To enable this, entities should register themselves as an Offline Verification Seeking Entity (OVSE) with UIDAI, to use the Aadhaar App-based verification services.
